Vandals documents the world-wide graffiti movement of writers, who leave their name on public transport. After several years of working under harsh conditions on four different continents, photographer Nils Müller has taken this series to unexpected dimensions and is now one of the most famous photographers to document graffiti.

In 2008, Müller released his book *Blütezeit*, which documented the international train painting culture. He is currently working on the follow up title *Vandals*, which is due to be released in early 2013.

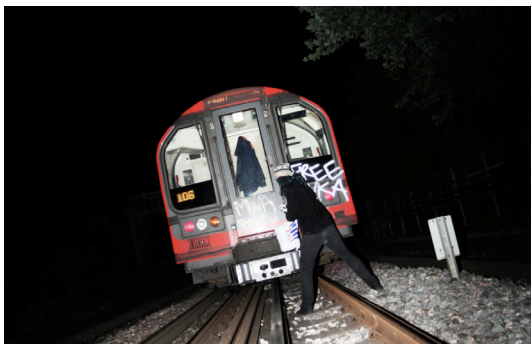

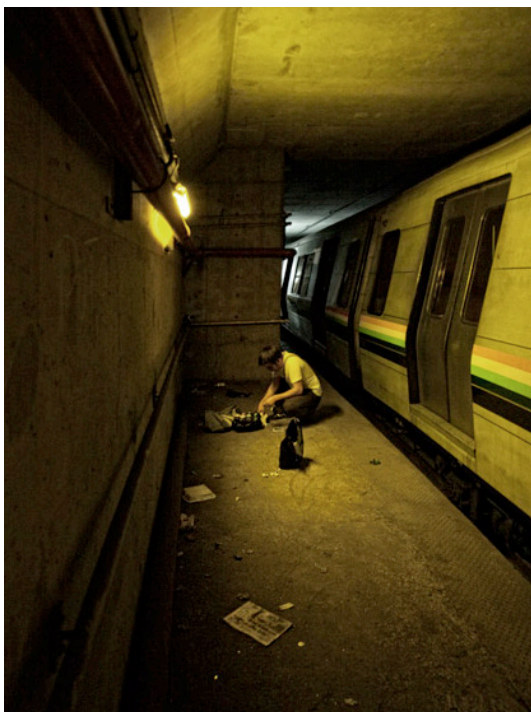

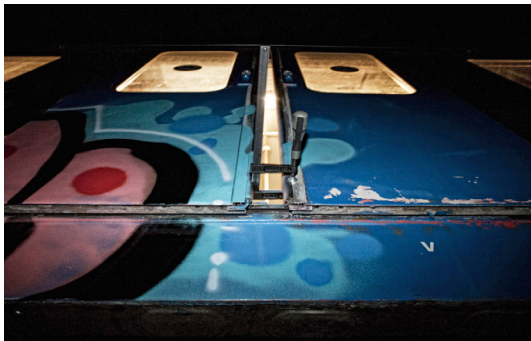
